Spiti Valley, known as the “**Middle Land**” between India and Tibet, is a high-altitude cold desert shaped by dramatic cliffs, ancient monasteries, and raw Himalayan beauty. In winter, it transforms into a surreal white landscape – silent, powerful, and unforgettable.

This **Adventures Wheel** expedition takes you from the pine forests of Shimla to the rugged terrain of Spiti, driving through the legendary roads of Kinnaur Valley and reaching Chitkul, the last inhabited Indian village near the Indo-Tibet border.

**Celebrate Holi** in Sangla amidst local traditions and mountain hospitality, with the majestic Kinner Kailash peaks as your backdrop.

## EXPLORE SPITI’S TIMELESS ICONS:

Tabo Monastery, Key Monastery, Chicham Bridge, and Hikkim Post Office – each a symbol of Spiti’s heritage and high-altitude spirit.

This isn’t just a trip – it’s a raw Himalayan adventure, crafted the **Adventures Wheel** way: bold, immersive, and unforgettable.



# BRIEF ITINERARY

## DAY 0

### Delhi → Shimla (Overnight Journey)

The adventure begins as we depart from Delhi for Shimla, leaving the plains behind and heading toward the Himalayas.

## DAY 1

### Shimla → Chitkul / Sangla

Distance: ~220 km | Duration: 9–10 hrs

Drive through the dramatic cliffs of Kinnaur Valley to reach Chitkul – the last inhabited Indian village near the Indo-Tibet border.

Overnight stay in Chitkul/Sangla amidst snow-clad peaks.

## DAY 2

### Chitkul / Sangla → Kalpa

Distance: ~70 km | Duration: 3–4 hrs

A scenic Himalayan drive to Kalpa, offering mesmerizing views of the Kinner Kailash range.

Overnight stay in Kalpa.

## DAY 3

### Kalpa → Nako → Tabo

Distance: ~168 km | Duration: 7–8 hrs

Cross high-altitude terrain and the beautiful village of Nako en route to Tabo.

Overnight stay in Tabo, home to the iconic Tabo Monastery.

## DAY 4

### Tabo → Dhankar → Kaza

Distance: ~125 km | Duration: 6–7 hrs

Visit the stunning Dhankar Monastery, followed by Key Monastery and the thrilling Chicham Bridge – Asia's highest suspension bridge.

Overnight stay in Kaza.

## DAY 5

### Langza – Komic – Hikkim (Highest Villages Circuit)

Distance: ~80 km | Duration: 6–7 hrs

Explore the high-altitude villages of Langza, Komic, and Hikkim Post Office, where you can send a postcard from one of the world's highest post offices.

Overnight stay in Kaza.

## DAY 6

### Kaza → Kalpa

Distance: ~215 km | Duration: 7–8 hrs

Retrace the legendary Spiti routes back to Kalpa.

Overnight stay in Kalpa.

## DAY 7

### Kalpa → Shimla → Overnight to Delhi

Distance: ~210 km | Duration: 8–9 hrs

Drive back to Shimla with unforgettable Himalayan memories.

Overnight transfer to Delhi.

## DAY 8

### Arrival in Delhi

Reach Delhi by morning – completing your high-altitude adventure the **Adventures Wheel** way: bold, immersive, unforgettable.

# DAY 1

## Reach Shimla – Drive to the Last Indian Village: Chitkul / Sangla

**Distance:** Approx. 220 km | **Duration:** 9–10 Hours

- ➔ Depart from Delhi by late evening and reach Shimla the next morning, refreshed and ready to begin your Himalayan road journey.
- ➔ Drive through Kufri and Narkanda along the scenic **Hindustan–Tibet Highway** (Indo-Tibetan Highway) on your way toward Sangla, witnessing changing landscapes from dense forests to dramatic mountain valleys.
- ➔ Enter the breathtaking **Kinnaur Valley** by crossing the iconic Kinnaur Gate, a famous rock-cut tunnel known as the Gateway of Kinnaur.
- ➔ Situated around 170 km from Shimla on the Shimla–Kaza road, this historic stretch is part of the legendary Hindustan–Tibet Road carved through towering cliffs.
- ➔ Continue your journey toward **Chitkul (or Sangla)**, the last inhabited Indian village near the Indo–Tibet (China) border.
- ➔ Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel in Chitkul / Sangla, soaking in the peaceful mountain atmosphere and crisp Himalayan air.
- ➔ In winter, the region transforms into a stunning white wonderland surrounded by snow-covered peaks and pristine landscapes.
- ➔ Reach Chitkul / Sangla by evening.



## DAY 2

### Chitkul / Sangla → Kalpa

**Distance:** Approx. 70 km | **Duration:** 3–4 Hours

- ➔ Wake up early in the morning and check out from the hotel.
- ➔ Visit **Chitkul** (subject to weather conditions and safety considerations) and soak in the serene views of the Baspa Valley one last time.
- ➔ Proceed toward Kalpa and make a stop at the famous **Roghi Cliff Point** near Roghi Village (visit subject to weather and road safety conditions). The cliff offers breathtaking panoramic views of deep valleys and rugged Himalayan terrain.
- ➔ Explore **Reckong Peo Market** (Peo Market), the largest market in Kinnaur district, where you can walk around, shop for local items, and experience the local lifestyle.
- ➔ Reach Kalpa by evening and relax while enjoying stunning views of the **Kinner Kailash** range.
- ➔ Check in to the hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at **Kalpa**



# DAY 3

## Kalpa → Tabo via Nako

**Distance:** 168 km | **Duration:** 7–8 Hours { **Overnight stay at Tabo** }

- ➔ Wake up early in the morning and after breakfast, begin your scenic journey deeper into the Himalayas toward Spiti Valley.
- ➔ Drive through the famous Ka Loops — a thrilling series of sharp mountain bends offering spectacular valley views — as you ascend toward Nako.
- ➔ **Reach Nako** and halt for lunch while enjoying the peaceful surroundings of this high-altitude Himalayan village.
- ➔ Continue ahead and officially enter Spiti Valley via the **Sumdo** border check-post, marking your arrival into the cold desert region of Himachal.
- ➔ Reach Tabo by evening and visit the oldest monastery in Spiti Valley, the iconic **Tabo Monastery**, known for its ancient murals and rich Buddhist heritage.
- ➔ Check in to the hotel/property. Dinner and overnight stay at Tabo.

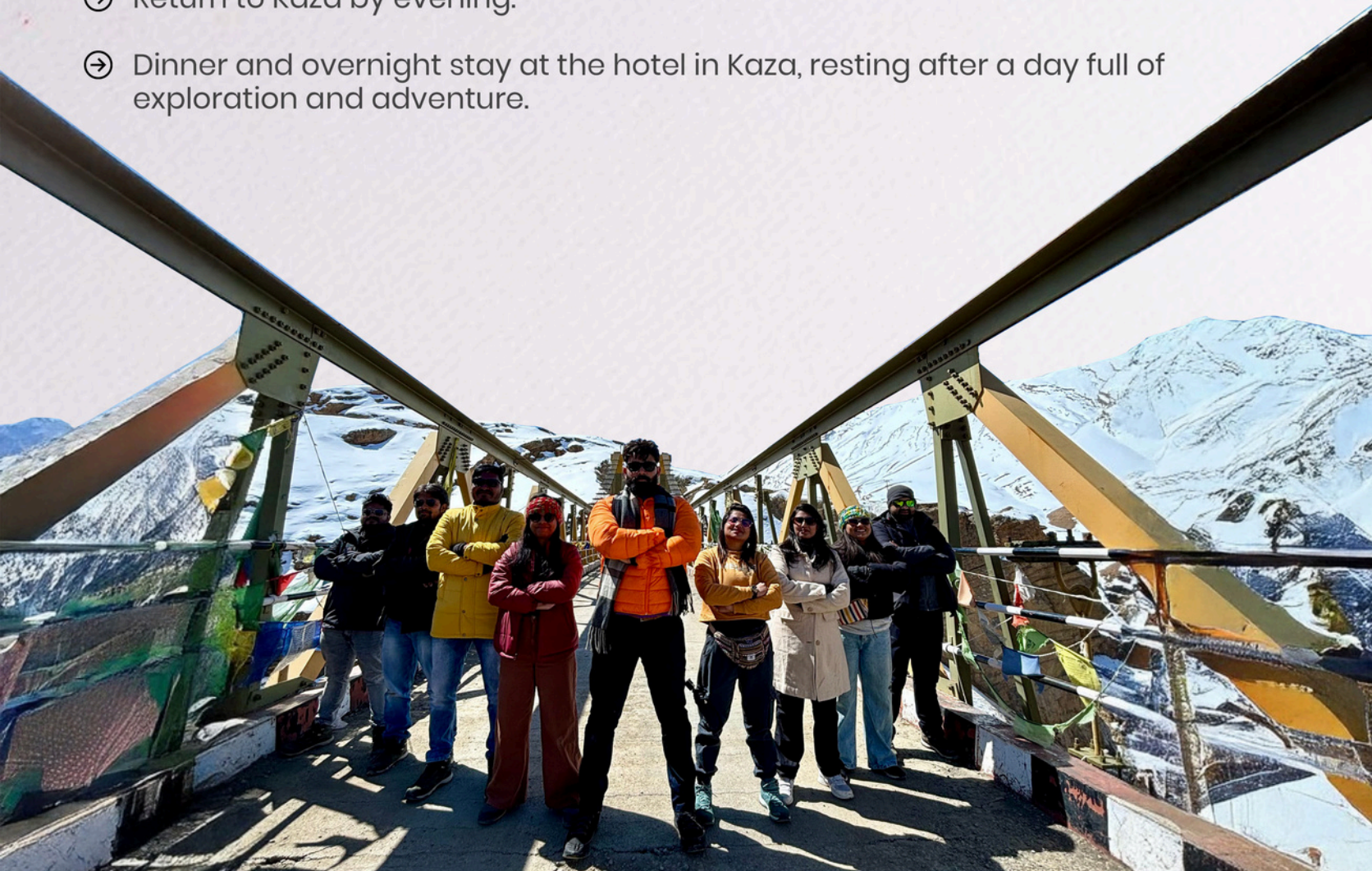


# DAY 4

## Dhankar – Key Monastery – Chicham Bridge → Kaza

**Distance:** Approx. 125 km | **Duration:** 6–7 Hours { Overnight stay at Kaza }

- ➔ Wake up early in the morning and after breakfast, start your day's exploration in **Spiti Valley**.
- ➔ Drive toward Dhankar Village and visit the historic **Dhankar Monastery**, beautifully perched on a cliff. The monastery offers spectacular views of the confluence of the Spiti River and Pin River.
- ➔ Continue your journey to the most scenic and iconic monastery of Spiti Valley – Key Monastery – known for its dramatic hilltop location and panoramic valley views.
- ➔ Further drive to **Chicham Bridge**, the highest suspension bridge in Asia, offering breathtaking views of the deep gorge below.
- ➔ Return to Kaza by evening.
- ➔ Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Kaza, resting after a day full of exploration and adventure.



# DAY 5

## Langza – Hikkim – Komic → Kaza

**Distance:** Approx. 80 km | **Duration:** 6–7 Hours { **Overnight stay at Kaza** }

- ➞ Wake up early in the morning and after breakfast, check out from the hotel and begin your exploration of Spiti's highest villages.
- ➞ Enjoy a scenic drive to Langza, famously known as the Fossil Village. Visit the **majestic Buddha** statue overlooking the valley, surrounded by striking white mountains and vast cold desert landscapes.
- ➞ Continue to Hikkim Post Office in Hikkim, home to one of the **world's highest post offices**, where you can send a postcard from this unique high-altitude location.
- ➞ Proceed to Komic, known as one of the highest villages in the world connected by a motorable road, offering spectacular panoramic views of the **Spiti Valley**.
- ➞ Return to Kaza by evening.
- ➞ Dinner and overnight stay at a **hotel in Kaza**, relaxing after a day of high-altitude exploration.



# DAY 6

## Kaza → Kalpa

**Distance:** 215 km | **Duration:** 7–8 Hours { Overnight stay at Kalpa }

- ➔ Wake up early in the morning and after breakfast, check out from the hotel in Kaza.
- ➔ Depart for Kalpa, retracing the scenic Spiti–Kinnaur route with mesmerizing views of rugged mountains, deep valleys, and the Spiti River flowing alongside.
- ➔ Enjoy the long yet beautiful drive as you descend from the cold desert terrain back toward the greener landscapes of Kinnaur.
- ➔ Reach Kalpa by night.
- ➔ Check in to the hotel and relax after the day's journey.
- ➔ Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Kalpa.



# DAY 7

## Kalpa → Shimla → Overnight to Delhi

**Distance:** 210 km | **Duration:** 8–9 Hours

- ➔ Wake up early in the morning and after breakfast, check out from the hotel.
- ➔ Depart for **Shimla**, enjoying the scenic Himalayan drive through the winding mountain roads and lush valleys of Kinnaur.
- ➔ Reach Shimla by evening and take a short break before continuing your onward journey.
- ➔ Later, depart for Delhi with unforgettable memories of your Spiti Valley expedition.

- Travellers outside Delhi should book trains/flights arriving no later than **4:00 PM on the trip start date.**  
On the return date, book onward flights/trains departing **after 12:00 PM** to avoid delays.
- The itinerary may change due to weather, road conditions, government regulations, or participant well-being.  
**Adventures Wheel** reserves the right to modify the schedule for safety, comfort, and group welfare.
- The age limit for group departures is **16 to 42 years** due to the high-altitude, demanding itinerary.  
Customized trips can be arranged for travelers outside this range.
- You will be traveling to high-altitude cold desert regions of India. Consulting your doctor beforehand for medical advice and altitude awareness is strongly recommended.
- Medical facilities in Spiti are limited. Adventures Wheel will assist in emergencies; however, medical or evacuation costs must be borne by the traveler.
- Participants should be physically fit and in good health. Please disclose any pre-existing medical conditions in advance so our team can guide you properly.
- During extreme winters, snowfall may restrict Tempo Traveller movement. In such cases, 4x4 vehicles will be arranged for safety and access.  
Any additional cost for 4x4 arrangements will be borne by travelers.
- Winter Spiti can witness heavy snowfall and route closures. Please be mentally prepared for flexible routing and true winter adventure conditions.
- For guest comfort in winter, each stay includes one complimentary heating facility – either an electric blanket or a room heater.
